SO 1	Introduction and identification of components of CPG	6 min	Using power point , explain the decision tree. Explains that each step is sequentially assessed. Points out that absence of midline neck & back tenderness must be ruled out prior to neck rotation. Explains that clinical judgement must be used and if in doubt immobilise. This should be very conservative in nature. If a patient is combative then attempts at restraint may cause more damage	Watch and listen and ask questions Where appropriate
SO 2	T.T.S.S.B.A.T Perform an assessment and extrication decision on a patient with life threatening injuries	8 min	Reads out scenario and gets student to correctly apply CPG to inform his/her decision and demonstrate the extrication using the equipment provided	Works in teams to Make extrication decision and correctly perform the patient extrication using the equipment provided.
